

NCSCA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

ONE APPLICATION per varsity high school team will be accepted.

Eligibility:

1. The applicant must participate in varsity high school softball her senior year AND must have participated in varsity or junior varsity softball her junior year.
2. The applicant must have applied to and received an official letter of acceptance from a legitimate public or private two or four-year college or university, and made an official commitment to attend said institution, or legitimately be in the process of doing so.
3. The applicant may not be the recipient of any type of college or university *athletic* scholarship, softball or otherwise.
4. The recipient must be an entering freshman, registering for classes any time during the next school year following her high school graduation.
5. Applicants are not required to have participated in a program whose coach is an association member. However, the Scholarship Committee may use this as a factor in determining award priority.
